1000x5 Project	Since 2008, it has been possible to collect more than 165,000 children's picture books for redistribution to babies, toddlers, and other young children on the Peninsula. That's more than ten times the number of books in most elementary school libraries. The majority of these books were donated through schools in Saanich District. Research indicates that home libraries have significant positive effects on the literacy development of young children and their early success in school. Success begets success. For these reasons, the PENINSULA "1000 X 5" Project work will continue until the end of June, over the summer, and throughout the next school year. You can help sustain the flow of books by encouraging your children to share the gift of literacy with others. They can donate books they have outgrown into the collection bin/box at school.
