CORN CASSEROLE	Veronica Lauener Grade 3
1 lb ground beef 5 large potatoes 1 large can cream corn 2 Tbsp minced onion	Salt and pepper 1 Tbsp butter 1/4 cup milk 1/4 tsp oil
Heat oil. Cook onion until tender. In same pan, fry ground beef; drain. Meanwhile, skin, cube and boil potatoes. Mash potatoes with milk and butter. Layer cooked ground beef, cream corn and potatoes in medium casserole. Bake at 350°F until heated through.	
Refrigerates well.
