TRANSPORTATION UPDATE

ALL bus students will receive their new bus pass for 2024-2025 on Tuesday, September 03. These bus passes are REQUIRED, for transportation safety reasons. Students MUST scan when getting on and off the bus. The transportation department has worked very hard to place each bus card into a plastic sleeve with a lanyard to help prevent lost cards. If your child loses their bus pass there is a \$10 new card fee.

Tuesday, Sept 03:

All buses are running the normal morning pickup route.

<u>Dismissal:</u> Lochside students will depart at 10:30am from Lochside. Please note that if it typically took 20 min to arrive at the pickup location, you will add 20 min to 10:30am - for ex: pickup would then be 10:50am at the pickup destination

Wednesday, Sept 04 onwards bussing will be on schedule for the morning and afternoon routes.

Parking Lot Protocol



As you know our parking lot is tight and can get very congested and full. Please take extra time and care when dropping students off and picking them up from school. Pay close attention to the Drop-Off areas and ensure that students are crossing the parking lot in a safe manner.

Please do not STOP right at the entrance to our parking lot. This causes cars and traffic to back up onto Royal Oak Drive.

Parents are reminded to not leave vehicles unattended in the Drive-Thru or Drop-Off lanes while picking up their child.
