

Important Notice regarding Pirate Pizza Party & Outdoor Classroom

Ahoy Lochside Parents!

This **Thursday October 23rd at 5:30pm is the LEPAC Pirate Pizza Party**. Funds raised at the event will be used to help build an outdoor classroom near the upper playground. Our goal for Thursday's Pirate Pizza Party will be **to raise \$2,000.00** for the outdoor classroom.

To reach this goal we have instituted a ticket system for food and activities similar to the one we used at last year's end of school picnic at Braefoot Community Centre.

The ticket system is very straightforward:

- Each ticket will cost \$1 with a special family pack of 25 tickets for \$20.
- 4 tickets will buy a pizza/hot dog meal and 1 ticket will purchase a cupcake
- Entry to major activities such as the Cupcake Walk and the courtyard's Haunted Pirate Lair will require one ticket per person.
- Additional donation bins will also be present, we thank you for your kind support.

Over the last several months many parents, students and teachers have given time and effort to this event. We have also received a variety of donations and volunteers from a diverse group including: the Maritime Museum of BC, Galey and Madrona Farms, Audrey Hayes Art Studio, Victoria Garden Sprinklers, Poppy Photography, Esquimalt Buccaneer Days, Claremont High School, UVic Drama Department and the Vancouver Island Pirates Association (VIP).
