- Thank you to all the teachers and admin for their support with all the activities LEPAC has been doing
- Thank you to Kirsty for all her work on fun lunch, Jamie for helping organizing volunteers for reading; Michelle for organizing the fruit & veg; Eva for the book shop; Anya and the sorters for the Purdy's fundraising
- Virtual wish tree
 - o All requests have been filled, just some WalMart gift cards missing
 - o Thank you to all the families who have fulfilled a wish
- Art cards went really well! Thank you to the teachers for their support in creating the art pieces! This fundraiser brought in about \$1,500 for LEPAC
- Communication with families
 - o Ongoing challenge families still rely on getting paper come home with their kids
 - o Not reading emails

Vice President's Report: Priyanka Gupta

- Heather Dalzell, ELL teacher, spoke to LEPAC about the possibility of receiving the same classroom budget as classroom teachers and French teachers receive
 - The ELL program serves 128 students in the school
 - The ELL staff are considered district based rather than school based, which is why they have not received this funding to date
- After discussion, the executive agreed to fund the ELL program with \$300 this year. ELL funding should be included in the school wish list for next year so that it can be included in the budget.
