 - o Thank you to all the families who attended
 - o Would be great to have a couple of other rooms to use for next year so there was some more space, for example for the cupcake walk
 - Would buy a pizza for the Key Club volunteers next year rather than paying for the food truck
 - o More lighting for the outside area would have been great
 - Food truck was great, look into other options for some variety and possibly a lower cost
- Holiday bookshop to be held Dec 7 and 8
- Holiday food drive / giving tree to start early December
 - o A class will decorate the house and other decorations will go out the week of Nov 28
 - o Leila to provide a list of items for the giving tree / wish list
 - End the food drive on Dec 14 so we can encourage families to bring a non-perishable food item to the concert
